About SMART

The SSI/SSDI application process is notoriously difficult; it is even harder for those with limited support and resources.

SMART's connects eligible individuals in Sacramento County with expedited access to Social Security disability and health care services. Our nationally accredited Benefits Advocates have formed unique partnerships with the Social Security Administration, State Disability Determination services, and local community based organizations to ensure the successful submission and resolution of disability claims.

Why Choose SMART?

SMART Benefits Advocates provide individual attention to each customer, assisting with everything from forms completion and gathering medical evidence.

SMART has connected more than 1,200 individuals in the Sacramento region with disability benefits.

- 1) Nationally accredited disability filing experts, who strictly specialize in disability claims.
- 2) SSI/SSDI success rates which are 5 times the national average for first time applicants.
- 3) To date, SMART's success rate for SSI/SSDI applications is 5 times the national average for homeless individuals. In addition, applications processed through SMART are approved three times faster!

Eligibility

To qualify for SSI, applicants must have one of the following:

- 1) Age 65 or older
- 2) Blind
- 3) Disabled and cannot work for 12 months
- 4) US Citizen or Permanent Resident prior to 8/21/1996

Additionally, SMART applicants must:

- 1) Clean & sober at least 90 days
- 2) Medical history showing severity of medical conditions
